When God feels silent in your life, do you trust that He is still moving behind the scenes? How can you rest in His promises today?

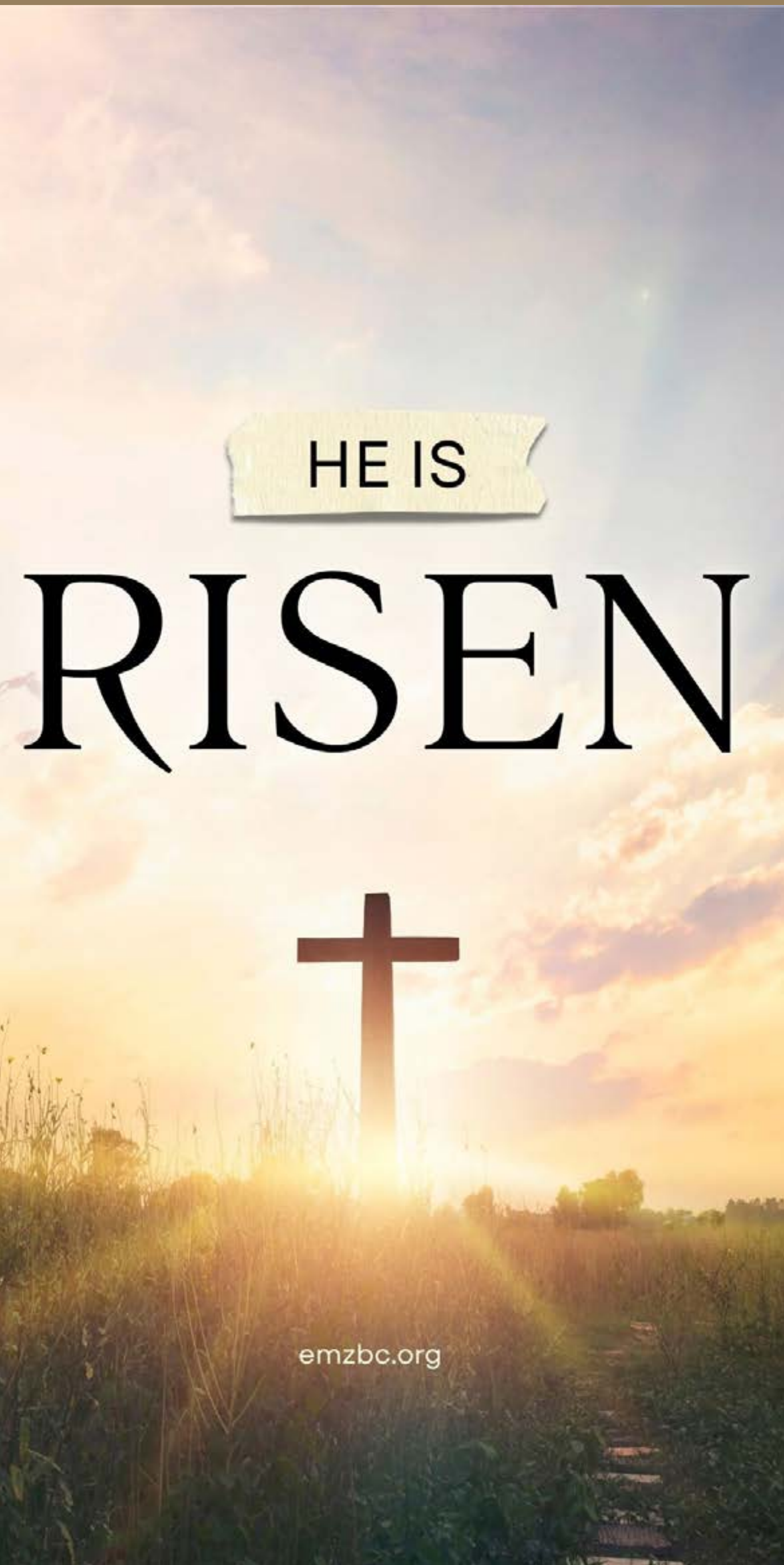
THE PRAYER
