Romans 3:7	If my dishonesty makes God's truth shine brighter, why am I still judged?	_____	God's glory never excuses our sin. We remain responsible before Him.
Romans 3:8	Should we continue doing evil so good may come?	_____	Absolutely not! Such reasoning deserves condemnation.
Romans 3:9	Are we better than they?	_____	No, not at all. Both Jews and Gentiles are all under sin.
